FARM ANIMAL REGULATIONS

Keeping of farm animals is allowed subject to Atascadero Municipal Code Sections 9-6.112 Farm animal raising, 9-6.109 Agricultural accessory buildings and the individual zoning district.

Minimum Lot Size & Zoning

- Farm animals allowed in RS & RSF zones; no farm animals are permitted in RMF or LSF zones
- Large animals (horses, donkeys, cows, pigs): one (1) acre minimum
- Small animals (goats & turkeys): one-half (1/2) acre minimum
- Chickens & other birds: no minimum lot size

Number of Animals

- The maximum allowable animal density for a site is established by "animal equivalency units"
- RS zone is allowed 3 units per acre, RSF zone is allowed 2 units per acre
 - Large animals (horses, donkeys, cows, pigs): Each animal equals one animal equivalency unit
 - Small animals (goats & turkeys): Two (2) animals equal one animal equivalency unit
 - Chickens & rabbits: 20 animals equal one animal equivalency unit
 - For the first two (2) acres, no more than one large animal shall be allowed for each full half acre
- Example: 2.8 acre parcel in the RS Zone would allow for 8.4 animal equivalency units, which is rounded to 8 units. This equals 4 horses, 6 goats, and 20 chickens, or other equivalent combination
- Additional animals may be permitted for youth projects or with a business license for small scale breeding

Setbacks

- Ag. buildings used to house farm animals (barns, stables, coops) shall have minimum front setback of 50 feet, plus minimum side and rear setbacks of 25 feet, <u>measured from the property line</u>
- Uncovered animal enclosures (corrals, pens, feed areas, uncovered stables) shall have minimum setbacks, <u>measured from the nearest building used for residential purposes on adjacent property:</u>
 - 100 foot minimum setback: pigs
 - 50 foot minimum setback: horses, donkeys, goats & turkeys
 - 25 foot minimum setback: chickens & rabbits
- The <u>occasional</u> grazing of domestic animals in the setbacks is allowed provided that the pasture area is adequately fenced or the grazing animal is securely restrained
- All poultry, turkeys and rabbits shall be contained in coops or pens and not be allowed to run free on site

<u>Maintenance</u>

• Premises shall be maintained in a neat and sanitary manner. All animal enclosures, buildings and pasture areas shall be maintained free from litter, garbage and the accumulation of manure.
